Vintage	2014
Production	7.469 bottles
Variety	90% Merlot 10% Picapoll Red
Winemaking method	Fermented over 10 days at 22 using yeast native to the state. Maceration takes place between 15 and 30 days. Pumping over is done twice daily. Tanks are drained without any pressing of the grapes.
Aging	Aged for twelve months in new 500 liter French oak barrels before aged a further 12 months in bottle. Locally sourced natural Catalan cork.
Tasting notes	Arnau Oller Estate Wine , is an expression of a region where the natural environment plays a leading role. An elegant full-bodied red with complex structures that bring smoothness and subtlety. A clear example of a well-balanced fruits with hints of rosemary, lavender and thyme and subtle tones of licorice. In summary Arnau Oller stands out as a fine, complex wine.
